



Financial Policy

Insurance Facts:

We accept many insurance plans and will help maximize your yearly benefits. We will bill your insurance company as a courtesy to you. Your insurance company makes the final determination of your eligibility by the policy your employer has contracted with them. **We cannot guarantee any insurance payments**, even on given estimates. We require that your estimated patient portion be paid at the time services are rendered.

Rogers Dental Center fees are based on care, skill, and judgment of the professionals delivering the services, and by the cost of operating a dental office dedicated to excellence. Our office does not diagnose, render treatment, or establish fees according to any insurance tables or allowances.

Financial Options:

We accept Visa, MasterCard, Discover, & American Express. We also have a partnership with CareCredit that offers extended payment options.

Charges to Account:

Payment is due at time of service unless other payment arrangements have been made in advance. If your account becomes past due, we will take the steps necessary to collect this debt. There is a \$30 fee for any checks returned by the bank.

Monthly Statements:

If you have a balance on your account, we will send you a statement. The balance on your statement is due and payable when the statement is issued. It is considered past due if not paid by the end of the month, unless other arrangements are approved in writing.

Any balances remaining over 60 days from date of service will be subject to a monthly \$10 late fee.

I understand that I am ultimately responsible for all charges for dental services and materials, regardless of my dental benefit plan. To the extent permitted under applicable law, I authorize the release of any information to my insurance company relating to my insurance claims. In addition, I authorize payment of dental benefits to be paid directly to Rogers Dental Center, P.A.
